TERMS OF REFERENCE (TOR)

1. SCOPE

1.1. Purpose

Bids are hereby invited for the **SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF CARRY-ALL TRAILER WITH POWER RODDER, RODS AND ASSOCIATED FITTINGS**

1.2. Background and description of project

Witzenberg Municipality includes the towns and rural areas of:

- Ceres,
- Prince Alfred's Hamlet,
- Op-die-Berg,
- Tulbagh, and
- Wolseley

Witzenberg Municipality is required to deliver services to the abovementioned areas. Road and Stormwater maintenance forms part of that responsibility and it's important to have the necessary equipment and materials.

1.3 PRE-QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

1.3.1. Minimum score for functionality

In order to be considered for a contract in terms of this bid, bidders must achieve the minimum score for functionality as stated below.

The description of the functionality criteria and the maximum possible score for each is shown in the table below. The score achieved for functionality will be the sum of the scores achieved for the individual criteria.

The minimum score for functionality is **31** out of a maximum possible score of **40**. Bidders that fail to achieve the minimum score for functionality will **NOT** be eligible for evaluation and their bid will be rejected.

Bidders that score at least 31 for functionality and are also specifications compliant will be evaluated according the 80/20 principal.

A more detailed explanation of the functionality criteria is given below:

1.3.2 Similar successfully completed projects

Bidders must complete **Schedule: Previous Experience**, which is a list of the bidder's past work experience in terms of similar successfully completed projects. The value and scale of the projects indicated for these purposes must be supplied together with the other relevant information requested based upon which up to **10 points** for functionality will be awarded to the bidder under consideration in this regard.

Note: Where the entity bidding is a joint venture, a score for track record will be awarded to each party to the joint venture which will then be combined in proportion to the percentage contribution of each party to the joint venture.

1.3.3 Quality

The products supplied must meet the needs of the Municipality and other stakeholders. It must meet statutory and regulatory requirements related to the products.

Bidders must complete **Schedule: Quality**, which lists the compliance of products to minimum standards and the company's quality management system based upon which up to **30 points** for functionality will be awarded to the bidder under consideration in this regard.

1.4. Functionality Evaluation Criteria

The scoring categories that will be used to evaluate the functionality submissions are shown below. Bidders are advised to carefully study these sheets to ensure that the correct information in this regard is provided in the relevant schedules of their bids.
